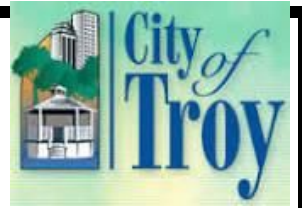




Summer Camp 2017
